Types of Financial Aid

Federal Pell Grant

Federal student aid from the U.S. Department of Education (ED) is money to help you pay your education expenses at a college, career school, university, or graduate school. Awarded to undergraduate students who have exceptional financial needs and have not earned a bachelor's or graduate degree; in some cases, students enrolled in a post baccalaureate teacher certification program may receive a Federal Pell Grant. These student aid funds do not have to be repaid. Federal Pell Grant lifetime eligibility is limited to 12 semesters or the equivalent. The quickest way to apply for federal student aid is online at **fafsa.gov**, where you will find the *Free Application for Federal Student Aid* or FAFSA®.
