The Bob & Marion Wilson Teacher Institute at Colonial Williamsburg has been at the forefront for 35 years providing immersive professional development based on primary sources to over 32,000 teachers from all 50 states and across the globe.

Teacher Institute participants are immersed in an authentic, inclusive, engaging learning environment and have an opportunity to exchange ideas with historians, meet character interpreters portraying people of the past, analyze primary sources, participate in historical simulations, and learn museum techniques that actively engage students in history.
