Basic graduation information for the Class of 2021:

- Six (6) tickets per graduate will be issued along with reserved seating. Groups of seats will be six (6) feet apart in the stadium.
- Graduations will take place rain or shine. In the event of severe weather, "rain dates" are scheduled for June 14, 2021, and June 15, 2021, at 6:00 p.m.
- Each school will communicate dates/times for regalia distribution and will share information about parking, entrances, allowable items in the venue, attire for graduates, etc.
