Return Stagger

<u>March 15</u>: Students with Disabilities - Self Contained, English Learners (All Levels 1, 2 and Some 3) and Pre K – 5 students. Grades 6 - 12 remain fully online with the current schedule, except for those students previously listed.

<u>April 12</u>: All middle school students begin hybrid schedule.

<u>April 26</u>: All high school students begin hybrid schedule.

Student Arrival

<u>Walkers</u>: Students come in following doors and go straight to classroom

PK-1st: Students will enter through the front playground door at the far end of the building.

2nd-4th Grade: Students will enter through the front door (main entrance)

5th -8th Grade: Students will enter through the Rec center doors at the far end of the building.

<u>Bus Riders:</u> Students will enter the building through the bus ramp door. Students will be unloaded one bus at a time.

100% of students can eat breakfast and lunch FREE of charge. Breakfast will be grab and eat in the classroom. Students will eat lunch in the cafeteria.

Concurrent Instruction

Student Dismissal

<u>Day Care Students</u>: They will be split up and sit 6 feet apart until their buses arrive.

<u>Bus Riders</u>: Teachers will seat bus riders outside their classroom door. A staff member will be stationed on each hallway to ensure **students stay separated until their bus is called.**

<u>Middle School Walkers</u>: Walked by teachers out the front doors.

<u>Pre-K</u>- Parents can pick students up at the pre-k door by the playground.

<u>Elementary Walkers/Parent Pick-up</u>: All K-5 walkers will dismiss from the black top behind the cafeteria/gym. Each teacher will walk their class to the assigned area behind the cafeteria/Gym.

No parents will be allowed on the blacktop. A teacher will call students using a megaphone from the gate.

Rainy day procedures: If rain is forecasted, please be prepared with the correct attire, because dismissal will continue as planned outside.

COVID MITIGATION STRATEGIES

- COVID pre-screening needs to occur every day before leaving home.
- If sick, students and staff MUST stay home.
- Students with COVID symptoms will be placed in an isolation room and their parent will be expected to pick them up promptly.
- Masks will be worn at all times (bus and school).
- Hand washing and use of hand sanitizer will be encouraged throughout the day.
- Students will maintain 6 foot distancing at all times (class seating, moving through hallways, lunch tables, recess)
- Students will not share supplies.
- Water fountains are closed. Students may bring water bottles.
- Bathrooms are limited to one person at a time.
- Bathrooms are sanitized frequently throughout the day.
- The building is sanitized every day.
- Shared spaces are sanitized between groups.
- No visitors will be permitted past the main office.
