Norfolk Public School’s state Standards of Learning (SOL) test window is as shown below. Each school selects their testing dates within the division window. Be advised, all dates are subject to change.

SOL (Grade 3-HS) Spring Reading, Math, Science, and Social Studies: May 10-June 11.

SOL tests measure achievement of the Virginia Standards of Learning in grades 3 through End-of-Course (high school). In addition, the End-of-Course level SOL tests are required to verify credit for graduation. The SOL tests must be administered in a face-to-face setting and taken online, unless otherwise indicated via a school committee.
