Lake Taylor School Dress Code/Mandatory Uniform Policy

To ensure that the educational process is conducted in an environment where safety risks, disruptions, and distractions are minimized, Lake Taylor School has adopted the following Uniform Dress Code. Students are expected to be in full uniform Monday through Friday, beginning the first day of enrollment and continuing throughout the school year.

All Students

Tops: Red (K-2), Orange (3-5), or Maroon (6-8) uniform blouse or shirt with collar/polo with collar (long or short sleeve)

Bottoms: Khaki Tan pants, jumpers, skirts, skorts, or shorts worn to the knee.

Shoes: No slides/open-toe shoes or rollers are allowed. To avoid injuries, students should wear appropriate shoes for physical education every day

Sweaters: Red/White/Off white/Orange/black/Maroon button-up cardigan or pullover sweater. ABSOLUTELY NO HOODIES will be permitted to be worn in the building, during the instructional day.

Turtlenecks: Red (K-2), Orange (3-5), Maroon (6-8) or Black: only if worn under short sleeve polo

Students are expected to be in full uniform Monday through Friday, beginning the first day of enrollment and continuing throughout the entire school year. The consequences for not adhering to the Mandatory Uniform Policy are as follows:

Consequences

 $1^{\rm st}$ Offense – Written Warning notice to parents/Phone call home to request a change of clothes or uniform will be offered to students

2nd Offense – Conduct Notice & Referral to Principal for Insubordination/Phone call home to request a change of clothes or uniform will be offered

3rd Offense - One day of In-School Suspension/Phone call home to request a change of clothes/uniform offered to students
