



Norfolk Public Schools 2025 Summer Food Service Program Information

School is (almost) out, summer meals are in! Norfolk Public Schools will once again participate in the Summer Food Service Program (SFSP). Meals will be provided to all children aged 18 and under without charge.

General Information:

The Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) is a federal USDA program.

Children must be present to receive a meal, and they must consume the meal on-site. A maximum of one breakfast and one lunch per child, per day, Mon- Fri, may be provided.

While participation in NPS summer academic programs is highly encouraged for students, it is not required to receive a meal. No application, registration, or proof of identification is needed for a child to receive a meal.

Meals provided are nutritious, tasty, and follow USDA's nutrition guidelines. Locally grown foods are utilized when possible.

Meal choices will be the same, regardless of race, color, national origin, sex (including gender identity and sexual orientation), disability or age, and there will be no discrimination.
