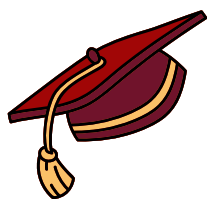

Booker T. Washington High School NHS Members Volunteer at Hope Educational Farm

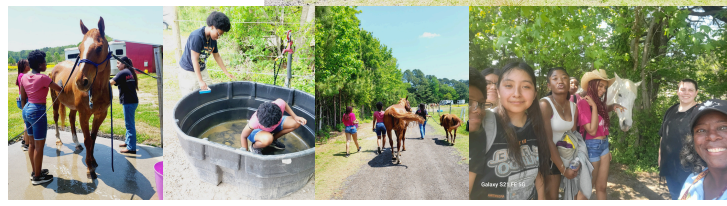
