**Internal SMARTE Goal:** By the end of the 2020-2021 school year through a collaborative school wide effort and the implementation of commonly agreed-upon strategies, 100% of Jacox Elementary School students will show measurable growth in their ability to read and comprehend a variety of text with 70% of students moving from one band area to the next in the four band areas, while the remaining 30% of the students will show growth within their band area as measured by the STAR assessment.

**External SMARTE Goal:** By the end of the 2020-2021 school year 70% of students at Jacox Elementary School in grades 3-5 will move from one band area to the next in three of the four band areas, while the remaining 30% of students will show growth within their band area as measured by the Virginia Standards of Learning.
