

FAIRLAWN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL MANDATORY UNIFORM POLICY

Uniforms may be purchased from Wal-Mart, Kmart, Sears, J C Penney, Kohl's and other retail stores in our area. Fairlawn also sells Royal Blue Polo shirts with long and short sleeves.

Uniform Guidelines

All shirts and blouses are to be worn tucked into the pants or skirts. All pants with belt loops must be worn with a dress belt. **Sweaters** and belts are to be plain with no embroidery or embellishments. NPS policy dictates no hoodies.

Girls

Tops: Royal Blue uniform blouse/polo with collar (long or short sleeves).

Bottoms: Khaki Tan pants, jumpers, skirts, skorts, or shorts worn to the knee.

Shoes: No shoes that light up or have rollers are allowed. To avoid injuries, student should wear appropriate shoes

for physical education every day

<u>Tights/Leggings:</u> White/off white only: NO PATTERNED leggings or tights

Sweaters: White/Off white/Royal blue/black button up cardigan or pull over sweater

ABSOLUTELY NO HOODIES OR JEAN JACKETS will be permitted to be worn in the building,

during the instructional day.

Turtlenecks: Royal Blue: only if worn under short sleeve polo

Boys

Tops: Royal Blue uniform shirt/polo with collar long or short sleeves.

Bottoms: Khaki Tan pants (not oversized) and shorts worn to the knee.

Shoes: None that light up or have rollers are allowed. To avoid injury, student should wear appropriate shoes for

physical education every day.

Sweaters: White/Off white/Royal blue/black button up cardigan or pull over sweater

ABSOLUTELY NO HOODIES OR JEAN JACKETS will be permitted to be worn in the building, during

the instructional day.

Turtlenecks: Royal Blue: only if worn under short sleeve polo

** Extreme haircuts/hairstyles and clothing contributes to disruptions to the teaching & learning process**

Students are expected to be in full uniform Monday through Friday, beginning the first day of enrollment and continuing throughout the entire school year. Consequences for not adhering to the Mandatory Uniform Policy are as follow:

Consequences

1st Offense – Written Warning notice to parents/Phone call home to request a change of clothes

2nd Offense – One day of In-School Suspension/Phone call home to request a change of clothes

3rd Offense - Conduct Notice & Referral to Principal for Insubordination/Phone call home to request a change of clothes
