Q4 Grading: Students will receive either a P for Pass or an I for Incomplete. A Pass is based on engagement in the Distance Learning Plan. To be clear, students must have an overall passing average for Q1, Q2, and Q3 and receive a (P) Pass for Q4 to move on to the next grade level or to pass the course for the year. If a student does not pass, summer school will be required.

Students, be sure to check your email! Check your messages from your teachers using your usual school log in information. You can find your email account on the NPS website on the "For Students" tab.

Packet distribution for Phase III will continue this coming week on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday between 11am and 1pm at the school. AGMS students must complete either assignments from teachers or the district learning plan to pass Q4.

Completed Packets. We will collect completed packets, but not just yet though. Hang on to those completed packets! Keep them in a safe place and we will let you know when and how to turn them in as soon as possible.

Report cards. Look for report cards to be mailed this week. With the report card will be an NPS Q4 insert as well as a letter sharing the results of our building wide water testing. You may recall that all NPS schools underwent comprehensive water testing for lead levels. The results of that testing for AGMS are included with your students' report cards and posted on the school website.
