

# Granby High Evening School





### **Granby High Evening School**

Granby High Evening School secondary program is designed for students desirous of taking a course for the first time or for students retaking failed courses.

The Adult High School Diploma program enables an adult no longer enrolled in public education to complete the required course/ activities to earn an Adult High School diploma, with Granby High Evening School scheduling classes and determining course requirements in accordance with standards established by the state. Each course requires 140 hours of classroom instruction for one credit.

Students attend Monday and Wednesday or Tuesday and Thursday, 4:30 p.m. - 8:40 p.m. Students are expected to attend every class and be on time. Only three absences per semester (six per year) are allowed. Letter grades will be issued at the end of the year. Students may earn one credit for each course passed. **The Individual Student Alternative Education Plan** (ISAEP) program prepares qualifying secondary students to earn a high school equivalency (HSE) credential while also developing career and technical skills. The ISAEP program fulfills compulsory attendance requirements for students who are at least 16 years of age and for whom an ISAEP is written.

### <u>ELIGIBILITY</u>

A student is eligible for enrollment in the ISAEP program if the student:

- is currently enrolled in a public high school
- is at least 16 year of age
- is at risk of dropping out of school
- is not earning the required number of credits at school
- meet academic entrance requirements
- chooses to prepare for the GED® Tests.

### **ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS**

- an initial principal-parents-student (PPS) meeting
- a student evaluation/assessment;
- a 7.5 grade equivalent or higher on a recognized standardized measure of reading test achievement; and
- achievement of a score of 125 or higher on each of the subtests of the four GED Ready<sup>TM</sup> practice subtests and completion of a career assessment
- a second PPS meeting.

### **Frequently Asked Questions?**

### What are the requirements to take classes?

Any student attending high school and taking courses are required to have a Norfolk Public Schools "Referral" form signed by the home school counselor and principal, along with a copy of an updated transcript. Adult students must be 18 years old and have at least a minimum of 15 certifiable credits.

### When may I register for classes?

Normal registration period starts the day after Labor Day. This applies to 18 and 36 week courses. January will be the second registration for 18 week courses.

### When is Granby High Evening closed?

Granby High Evening School is closed whenever Norfolk Public Schools is closed. We follow the NPS academic calendar.

### What are the office hours?

Granby High Evening School is open Monday - Thursday from 2 p.m. until 8 p.m. and Fridays 7:30 a.m. until 2:30 p.m.
