Payments can be made directly by cash, check, or money order. Please make sure all checks have two valid phone numbers and a driver's license number on the check. You may order online by going to the <u>TreeRing Order Center</u>, and pay via credit card. When you purchase a book, you can <u>activate an account</u> that allows you to customize two pages with whatever information you like (subject to approval) that will make your yearbook special. You can put your own pictures and written content right in the pages! These two pages will be in your book only. To customize the two pages, you will need the Maury passcode: **1014854445272931**. It is embedded into the "activate an account" link above. Senior quotes and baby pictures for the yearbook are due on November 22. You can submit a baby picture for \$15. Bring them to school to scan, or email them to <u>mauryhsyearbook@gmail.com</u>. Senior quotes are free, and can be submitted on the <u>senior quote form</u>.
