Azalea Gardens Middle School Instructional Focus

The instructional focus of Azalea Gardens Middle School is for all students to show measurable growth in *reading, writing, and learning for excellence* through the implementation of a school wide focus on *reading and writing across the content areas* as measured by SOL scores, a common writing rubric, and STAR reading.

What is it?

The Azalea Gardens Middle School Principal's Advisory Council (PAC) seeks to establish a strong relationship between students, teachers, parents and administration. The PAC, comprised of students in grades 6-8, works from a student's perspective to communicate and facilitate action towards solving school issues. Members of the Principal's Advisory Council represent the student body's voice to the principal. These members are also ambassadors for the school.

What is involved?

The Council meets with the principal to provide their input on school issues. Student members may also participate in school-wide events held throughout the year. Students are asked to commit to being a member for one year. Staff may meet at optional meetings. Parents are also welcome to join via Zoom on the designated dates below.

When is it?

Students will receive two introductory sessions on December 15 and December 16. Subsequent meetings will be held in room 109 from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. Transportation and meal/snack will be provided. Teachers will also meet after school in a designated location. Parent meetings are held from 5:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m. via Zoom.
