- 1. Tuition for the program is free for students attending Norfolk Public Schools. Transportation is provided at no extra charge.
- 2. Registration forms can be found online on our district website or accessible by QR code.
- 1. Grade level is determined by the 2020-2021 school year placement. This program is for students who were in Grades 8-11 during the 20-21 School Year.
- Digital Google Form applications will come directly to the correct office when submitted online. Only when the completed registration form is received by the Rosemont Center- Art Office is the student enrolled. Enrollment is on a first-come, first-served basis. Registration closes Friday, May 7, 2021 or earlier if classes are full. If a class is full, the student will be offered an alternate course.

- 6. During the week of June 7th, information regarding program logistics will be mailed to the parents of registered students.
