



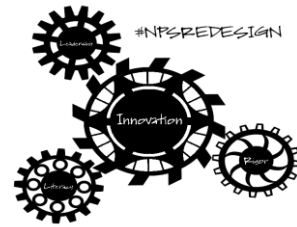

In-Depth Study



ALM, the foundation of the Young Scholars program, presents students the opportunity to study areas of interest in depth through seminars, master classes and mentorships,



Student Choice



Student choice is an essential element of ALM, and the Young Scholars program. Students choose topics of interest to investigate and develop autonomy in their thought as well as their actions.



Independence



The five dimensions of ALM foster independence by building soft skills such as inter/intrapersonal skills, organizational skills, an understanding oneself as a gifted learner.

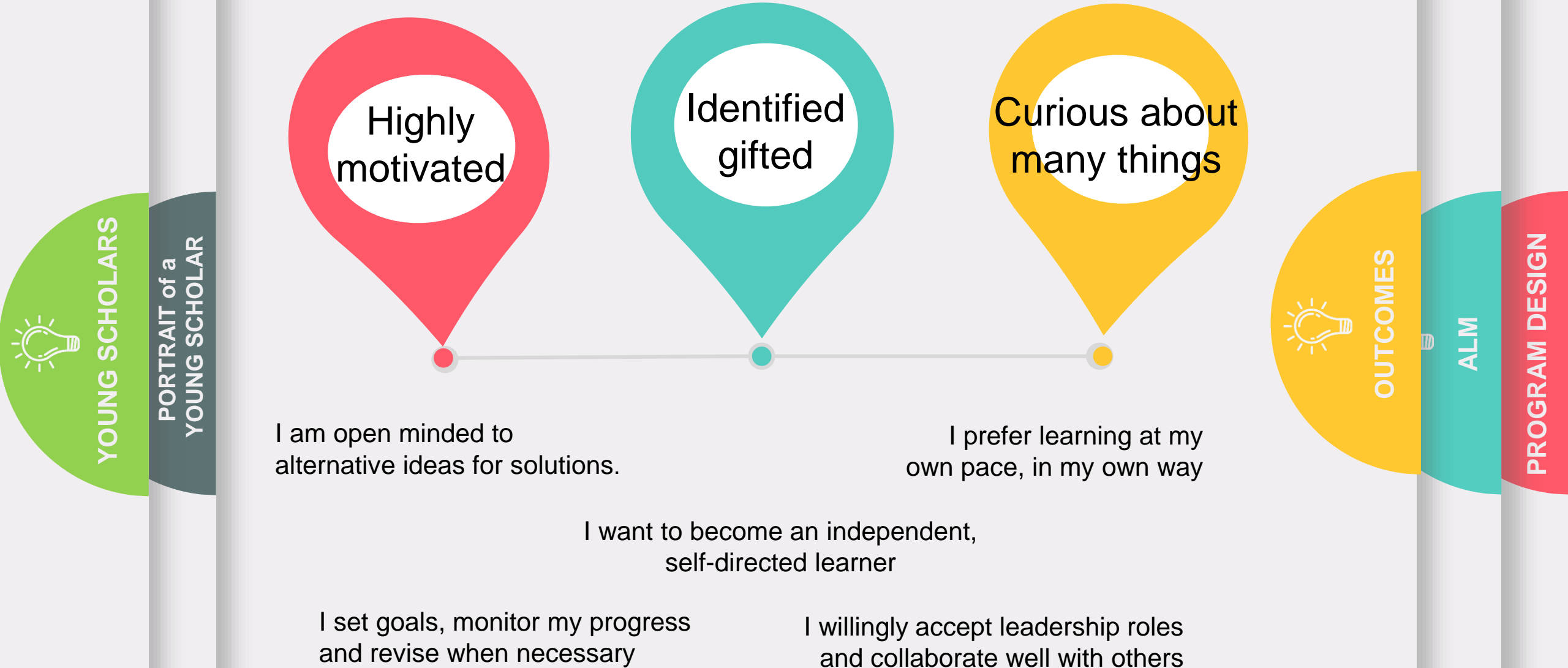
