Overview of Seventh Grade STAR Results in Reading

Strengths: According to the most recent STAR test data, 75% of 7th grade students showed growth in reading.

Opportunities for growth: The STAR test identified reading stamina as an issue. This trend has become prominent on the district benchmark assessments as well.

Students will be reviewing and enhancing skills in fiction, nonfiction, and vocabulary development in preparation for the SOL test.

At Home:

Parents can encourage students to read a variety of literature independently for at least 20 minutes each night to build stamina, speed, and comprehension.

Seventh Grade Life Science


Seventh grade focuses on Life Science. We have been learning about evolution, natural selection, ecosystems, and biomes.
