

COVID-19 TESTING

Beginning Tuesday, January 11, COVID-19 testing is available Saturdays – Thursdays, 9:00 a.m. – 5:30 p.m., at Military Circle Mall **by appointment only.**

To Make an Appointment:

Tests provided are PCR tests and results may take up to 48-72 hours. Result notification will be sent to the phone number used to set the testing appointment. Results are made available online or can be requested via phone number.






Who Should Get Tested:

- People who have symptoms of COVID-19.
- People who have come into close contact with someone with COVID-19 should be tested at least 5 days after they last had close contact with someone with COVID-19. The date of the last close contact is considered day 0.

Who Does NOT Need to Get Tested:

- People who have tested positive for COVID-19 within the past 3 months and recovered, as long as they do not develop new symptoms, do not need to get tested.

Know When to Get Tested:
