**Gifted Education & Academic Rigor Services (GEARS) Update:** At 6:18 Ms. Stead announced the following:

  - o Ms. Stead explained that the Local Gifted Plan is a state-mandated document that describes how districts provide gifted services. The 2022-2027 Local Gifted Plan includes a talent pool initiative to improve equity and consistency throughout the school division. The plan includes professional development (PD) opportunities for faculty and specific PD requirements for GRTs. The overall intent of the plan is to concentrate more on services, and provide more opportunity for children with a talent pool, clustering in elementary schools, and the ability for students to explore their interests in clubs and other after-school opportunities.
  - o The purpose of GEAC is to review annually the local plan for the education of gifted students and to determine the extent to which the plan for the previous year was implemented. GEAC's findings and recommendations regarding the effectiveness of the annual program, submitted annually in writing to the School Board and Superintendent, will be completed by June, 2023.
  - There is a First Grade Universal Screening under the local plan including revised benchmarks, emerging scholars services available to top 15% scorers in every school, and increased focus on enrichment and exposure for all students.
  - o The College of William and Mary will continue to collaborate with NPS and assist in further PD and the development of evaluation mechanisms to assess the efficacy of gifted services.
  - GRTs have been asked to solicit proposals at their schools for after school enrichment programs. NPS faculty are being offered a stipend to develop and oversee after school enrichment programs. The programs will begin as early as October. It was asked whether community members could volunteer or receive a stipend but that is not yet available as the program is not yet fully developed. It was noted that the enrichment programs would be similar to Camp Einstein. <u>https://www.npsk12.com/Page/14520</u>
  - o The initial focus of enhancements is at the elementary level, but the long-term goal is to provide more services in secondary schools.
