

2. ACCIDENT
3. BOMB THREAT
4. VIOLENCE

❖ HOW TO GET OFF THE BUS QUICKLY

- ❖ LEAVE EVERYTHING ON THE BUS
 - ❖ WHERE TO EXIT
 - ❖ DRIVER IS IN CHARGE
- ❖ DRIVER MAY NEED ASSISTANCE



STUDENT BEHAVIOR IS EVERY IMPORTANT:

- ▶ LISTEN TO THE DRIVER'S INSTRUCTIONS
- ▶ YOU MUST SIT FACING FORWARD
- ▶ BE PATIENCE
- ▶ BE ALERT
- ▶ LEAVE ALL ITEMS ON THE SEAT
- ▶ BE COURTEOUS
- ▶ DO NOT PUSH OR SHOVE
- ▶ KNOW YOUR EXIT**



Emergency Evacuation

- When might you evacuate?
 - Accident
 - Fire
 - Emergency where you need to leave bus quickly
- There are 3 ways to evacuate the bus
 - Front door
 - Rear door
 - Front and rear door

REAR DOOR EXIT




WHAT EXIT TO USE IF BUS IS ON ITS SIDE?



ROOF HATCH & WINDOW EXIT




Stay out of the Danger Zone!!!



More Emergency Evacuation (1)



- Buses also have
 - Roof hatches
 - Emergency windows
- In all types of evacuation:
 - Listen to bus driver's instructions
 - Remain calm
 - Remain quiet
 - Stay seated until it is your turn to leave
 - Unload one row at a time



Be Safe: Know Evacuation Procedures

- **While Evacuating**

- After you are out of the door, move away from the bus as this clears the way for others to follow.
- Go a distance of at least 100 feet from the bus and remain there in a group until given further instructions by the driver.
