SEAC is an extension of the local school board as members are appointed by them. The committee provides reports and recommendations to the local school board.*

Accordingly, the Norfolk Public Schools SEAC is a collaborative team parents of children with of disabilities. individuals with disabilities, a teacher representative, community representatives and stakeholders. The Senior Director and/or Assistant Director of Learning Support – Special Education Services and a representative from the school board serve as consultants to the committee.

*Advisory Committee members must be residents of the City of Norfolk or employees of Norfolk Public Schools or the City of Norfolk. The Board may consider a request to waive the residency requirement on an individual basis.

What are the functions of SEAC?

- Advise the local school division of needs in the education of children with disabilities;
- Participate in the development of priorities and strategies for meeting the identified needs of children with disabilities;
- Submit periodic reports and recommendations regarding the education of children with disabilities to the division superintendent for transmission to the local school board;
- Assist the local school division in interpreting plans to the community for meeting the special needs of children with disabilities for educational services;
- Review the policies and procedures for the provision of special education and related services prior to submission to the local school board; and
- Participate in the review of the local school division's annual plan.
