II. Consequences of Policy Violations

- 1st Offense: Verbal warning and parent/guardian communication.
- 2nd Offense: Written warning and parent/guardian communication.
- **3rd Offense**: Confiscation of the device; returned to the student at the end of the school day with parent/guardian communication.
- 4th and Subsequent Offenses: Confiscation of the device; returned only to a parent/guardian, with additional disciplinary actions as necessary.

Repeated infractions may lead to further disciplinary measures under the Standards of Student Conduct. Any disciplinary infraction that a student commits arising from the school administration's attempt to enforce this policy shall result in disciplinary consequences determined by the Standards of Student Conduct and the NPS Level System.
