



Why is Maury High School starting the first nine weeks of school virtually?

In the best interest of the health and safety of all NPS Stakeholders, the Norfolk School Board voted in July to open all Norfolk Public Schools virtually in the fall for the first nine weeks of school. The school district in conjunction with Norfolk's Health Department will evaluate Covid-19 data to determine how teaching and learning will take place thereafter.

When is the first day of school for virtual learning and what are the student hours?

School will start on Tuesday, September 8, 2020 at 7:25am and end at 2:05pm. Students will follow their virtual schedule every day. When will my student's schedule be ready?

Maury has finalized schedules so that they are available for viewing in StudentVue and ParentVue. They were mailed out this past week.

Why are Maury students expected to start at 7:25am?

Norfolk Public Schools want to keep the same start times for students whether they attend school virtually or in person.

Will Maury High School have regular office hours?

At this time, office hours for the regular school year have not been determined. Our main office remains open Tuesdays and Thursdays, from 10:00am-2:00pm. Wearing face masks is required when entering the building.

Will teaching and learning look the same as it did during the spring quarantine?

No, this year students will be expected to login to a live Zoom class session, following their daily bell schedule. The first class of the day will start at 7:25am and students are expected to be logged in and ready to learn at that time. Students will have the opportunity to ask questions and work with their peers. They will receive assignments with deadlines. Students will be graded following the traditional grading system including classwork, homework, projects, quizzes, and tests. Paper packets will not be made available. Will attendance be taken daily?

Yes, daily attendance, along with class period attendance will be taken. Students must login each day and each bell for official attendance to be taken.

What technology is available to help my student with virtual learning?

The district has ordered Chromebooks for each student. Chromebooks are expected to arrive late August. T-Mobile Hotspot Wifi (mifi) devices are also available for students who need internet access.

If my student already has a device from NPS, what do I need to do?

Students who have received a device from Maury High School as a 9th, 10th or 11th grader last year, may continue to use it. Each device was recorded in our database and is the student's responsibility. Any senior who graduated needs to return the device to Maury. Students coming from other NPS schools as rising 9th graders or transfers, must either return the device to their previous school or to Maury where they will be issued a new one. Maury will ensure that the returned device is sent back to their previous school.

Maury staff will contact parents/guardians to schedule appointments at mutually agreeable times, in designated school locations, under social distancing guidelines and with appropriate health mitigation practices in place.
