LAKE TAYLOR SCHOOL MANDATORY UNIFORM POLICY

Uniforms may be purchased from Wal-Mart, Kid's Rainbow, Children's Place, Old Navy, Target, J C Penney, Kohl's and other retail stores in our area or online. Lake Taylor School also sells polo shirts with long and short sleeves.

Uniform Guidelines

All shirts and blouses are to be worn tucked into the pants or skirts. All pants with belt loops must be worn with a belt. Sweaters and belts are to be plain with no embroidery or embellishments.

Girls

<u>Tops:</u> K- 2nd Grades <u>Red</u> uniform blouse/polo with collar (long or short sleeves).

3rd - 5th Grades **Orange** uniform blouse/polo with collar (long or short sleeves).

6th -8th Grade <u>Maroon</u> uniform blouse/polo with collar (long or short sleeves).

Bottoms: Khaki Tan pants, jumpers, skirts, skorts, or shorts worn to the knee.

Shoes: Closed toe shoes only. No shoes that light up or have rollers are allowed. To avoid

injuries, students should wear appropriate shoes for physical education every day.

Tights/Leggings: White/off white/ color of grade level shirt/Black only: NO PATTERNED leggings or tights (only

if worn under skirts or skorts)

Sweaters: White/Off white/black/Color of grade level shirt button up cardigan or pull over sweater

ABSOLUTELY NO HOODIES OR JEAN JACKETS will be permitted to be worn in the

building, during the instructional day.

Turtlenecks: Black or color of grade level shirt: only if worn under short sleeve polo

Boys

Tops: K- 2nd Grades **Red** uniform polo with collar (long or short sleeves).

3rd – 5th Grade Orange uniform shirt/polo with collar (long or short sleeves).

6th - 8th Grade Maroon uniform shirt/polo with collar (long or short sleeves).

Bottoms: Khaki Tan pants (not oversized) and shorts worn to the knee.

Shoes: Closed toe shoes only. None that light up or have rollers are allowed. To avoid injury,

student should wear appropriate shoes for physical education every day.

Sweaters: White/Off white/black/Color of grade level shirt button up cardigan or pull over sweater

ABSOLUTELY NO HOODIES OR JEAN JACKETS will be permitted to be worn in

the building, during the instructional day.

Turtlenecks: Black or color of grade level shirt: only if worn under short sleeve polo

Students are expected to be in full uniform Monday through Friday, beginning the first day of enrollment and continuing throughout the entire school year. Consequences for not adhering to the Mandatory Uniform Policy are as follows:

Consequences

1st Offense – Written Warning notice to parents/Phone call home to request a change of clothes

2nd Offense – Conduct Notice & Referral to Assistant Principal(s) for Insubordination/Phone call home to request a change of clothes

3rd Offense - One day of In-School Suspension/Phone call home to request a change of clothes
