

Dear Parents/Guardians of LTS students,

Norfolk Public School's district Standards of Learning (SOL) upcoming test window is listed below. Each school selects their testing dates within the division window. Be advised, all dates are subject to change due to circumstances. Spring Non-Writing (grades 3-High School): May 8-June 2

SOL tests measure achievement of the Virginia Standards of Learning in grades 3 through End-of-Course (high school). In addition, at the End-of-Course level SOL tests are required to verify credit for graduation. The SOL tests continue to be required to administer in a face-to-face setting. All will be administered online, unless otherwise indicated via a school committee.

Families will be notified of results through the online Parent Portal provided by VDOE. Parent Portal is a system that will allow parents to log in to see their child's test scores. Scores will be available in the Parent Portal within a week of the date the test was administered. Access codes will be sent home during the beginning of the test window. Through the Parent Portal, parents can see scores and specific skills performed well and those which additional support may be needed.

Below is Lake Taylor School's testing schedule for the Spring Non-Writing test window:

- May 15 – Grade 5 Science, Grade 8 Science, Honors 7 Science
- May 17 – Grades 3-8 Reading
- May 19 – Virginia Studies, Civics and Economics, Honors 7 & World Geography
- May 23 – Grades 3-8 Math, Algebra I & Geometry

If your student continues to be learning in a virtual environment, you will be contacted by school staff to discuss individual test dates.
