Dear NPS Parents/Guardians,

Norfolk Public School's Virginia Standards of Learning (SOL) test window is shared below for the 2020-2021 academic year. Each school selects their testing dates within the division window. Be advised, all dates are subject to change.

- VA SOL Spring 2021 Grades 3-4: Reading & Math- May 10 to June 11
- VA SOL Spring 2021 Grade 5: Reading, Math, Science, & Virginia Studies-May 10 to June 11

VA SOL assessments measure mastery and growth of the Virginia Standards of Learning in grades 3-12. This year, scores will not be used for school accreditation, but as a baseline to measure the impact of the pandemic closure. SOL tests are required to be administered in a face-to-face setting. All tests are taken in one day, are untimed, and will be administered online, unless otherwise indicated by an Individualized Education Plan (IEP) or a 504 Plan.

Parents/Guardians will be notified of SOL results by mail once individual score reports are received this summer.
