"caterpillar"
"a green caterpillar" or
"I made a green
caterpillar."
-Ask, "What color is the
caterpillar?"
-Encourage your child to
say "green" or "it's
green" or "The
caterpillar is green."

If your child is preverbal/ pointing: -Have them to point and

If your child is exploring and needs additional support:

- use hand- over- hand

support or hand on

If your child is verbal:

If your child is pre-verbal/pointing:

If your child is exploring and needs additional support:

Play peekaboo with desired item

If your child is verbal:
Have your child recall
food items that were just
eaten, then put his/her
used utensils in the
dishwasher, sink, or
trash.

If your child is pre-verbal/pointing: Have your child to identify the sink or trashcan. Give your child the used utensil, then help him/her to put it in the trashcan or sink.

If your child is exploring and needs additional support:

Start by telling your child, "Clean up". Then using hand over hand support, assist your child with wiping their area, their hands, and their face.

If your child is verbal:

-label bugs and insects-talk about which bugs/insectscan crawl or fly

If your child is pre-verbal/pointing:

-ask them to point to particular bugs/insects or items in nature

If your child is exploring and needs additional support:

-use hand over hand support to help your child touch named items -incorporate textures -use names of items to continue to support a language model
